

A Clean or Unmodified opinion was issued by the Auditor!








- * BRRWC has 3 Separate Service Areas:

 - * Cliffs Valley North = 1%
- * The Total of all areas cover 18% of Greenville County, S.C.



BRRWC Systems have:

- * More than 140 Sq. Miles of Service Area
- More than 500 Miles of Water Mains that are maintained and repaired by Staff Members
- More than 3,800 System Valves and more than 1,000 System Blow-offs that are maintained regularly, as well as repaired by Staff Members



* The Three Geographically Separate Sections of the BRRWC should be financially solvent with separate water rates set to insure each section's solvency




Chairman's Report

Driving Philosophy 2

Historical Area:

* New Customers and Developers should pay for the infrastructure improvements necessary to accommodate those new system customers and development









Section 3.5 Nominating Committee. Not later than forty-five (45) days prior to each annual meeting of the Members, the Chairman of the Board of Directors shall appoint a nominating committee consisting of three (3) members, two of whom shall be current Members of Board of Directors. Such committee shall consider all available candidates for the directorships to be filed at the forthcoming annual meeting and shall submit a slate of candidates at the meeting. 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
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

Developments

- Wofford Road Duplexes
 - * 310 LF of Water Main & 2 Hydrants
- * Carolina Crossroads RV Park
 - * 120 LF of Water Main & 1 Hydrant
- * Maplewood Estates
 - * 990 LF of Water Mains to Serve 16 Homes
- * North Greenville University Fire Protection
 - * 260 LF of Water Main & 2 Hydrants



Developments

- * Lakeside Cottages Phase 2 Subdivision
 - * 760 LF of Water Mains to Serve 63 Homes
- * 169 Old Rutherford Road Improvement
 - * 1 Hydrant Support 6 Homes
- * BR Plantation Zone 3A, Sec. 1 Subdivision
 - * 1,720 LF of Water Mains to Serve 44 Homes
- * CVN Line Replacement Panther Park to Timberbluff
 - * 2,273 LF of Water Main Replacement / Improvement

Current Systems Improvements

- Replacement of 16,100 LF of 6" PVC water main (1972), with an upgraded new 12" DIP water main & 16 hydrants along HWY 414, from HWY 253 to HWY 101
- Replacement of 6,500 LF of 6" PVC water main (1972), with an upgraded 12" DIP water main & 6 hydrants along Jordan Road, from HWY 101 to the Pleasant Hill Tank





Current Systems Improvements

- * Replacement of 1,100 LF of 6" PVC water main (1977), with an upgraded 12" DIP water main & 1 hydrant along HWY 25, from the Coon Top Tank to HWY 290
- * Replacement of 9,700 LF of 6" PVC water main (1972), with an upgraded 10" DIP water main & 8 hydrants along HWY 290, from the HWY 25 to Henderson Road



Current Systems Improvements

- * Replacement of 4,350 LF of 6" PVC water main (1972), with an upgraded 8" DIP water main & 4 hydrants along HWY 290, from Henderson Road to Tigerville Road
- * Replacement of Coon Top Tank, a 200,000 gallon ground storage tank (1977), with an upgraded 500,000 gallon elevated storage tank
- * Replacement of HWY 414 pump station (1990), with an upgraded pump station to deliver water throughout the system

Current Systems Improvements

- * South Carolina Infrastructure Investment Program (SCIIP) is a major, one-time initiative to improve water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure throughout the State of South Carolina
- * The Program utilizes federal funds allocated to the State through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021



Current Systems Improvements

- * Blue Ridge Rural Water Company was awarded \$9,118,123 from SCIIP for Water System upgrades and improvements
- * The BRRWC local investment or match is \$3,210,000
- * Total system improvement proposed investment is \$12,328,123
- * This will be the largest one-time investment ever made in the Blue Ridge Water System
